

BIOGRAPHY

Almir da Silva Mavignier (Rio de Janeiro, 1925 - Hamburg, 2018)

He begins his studies with Árpád Szenes, Axl Leskoschek and Henrique Boese in 1945, Rio de Janeiro. Between 1946 and 1951, he founds the Painting and Modeling Workshop of the Occupational Therapy Section of Engenho de Dentro Psychiatric Hospital (currently the Museu de Imagens do Inconsciente) with the psychiatrist Nise da Silveira. Mavignier, after learning the theories of Mário Pedrosa, he initiates his research in the area of abstraction. In 1949 he participates in the first group of Abstract Art in Rio de Janeiro with Ivan Serpa, Abraham Palatnik and Mário Pedrosa. In the same year, Mavignier makes the first abstract watercolor *Estudos*. Later, he produces paintings with geometric and organic forms in which he reduces the number of colors, but maintains halftones and the expressive brush-stroke of his figurative work.

In 1950 he has his first solo exhibition at the Institute of Architects of Brazil (IAB) in Rio de Janeiro. The following year, he travels to Paris, where he attends the Académie de La Grande Chaumière. In Germany, between 1953 and 1958, he studies with Max Bense and Josef Albers at the Hochschule für Gestaltung in Ulm. Max Bill introduces the constructive movement to Almir that later becomes his main influence. He participates in the Zero Group between 1958 and 1964 with Heinz Mack, Otto Piene, Yves Klein and Jean Tinguely. In 1960 he designs and organizes the exhibition *Nuove Tendenze*, the first international Op Art event in Yugoslavia. During the same years he participates at Documenta III and Documenta IV in Kassel, Germany and at three editions of Venice Biennale in 1964, 1968 and in 1986. He teaches painting at the Hochschule für Bildende Künste in Hamburg, Germany, between 1965 and 1990.
